Beach FC U17G Red (Formerly Piranhas) 2010 US CLUB SOCCER NATIONAL CHAMPIONS

The Beach FC U17G Red (formerly Piranhas) competed in the 2010 National Cup IX Finals and National Collegiate Showcase which kicked off on July 24 in Virginia Beach at the Hampton Roads Soccer Complex. The 2010 National Cup IX Finals came to a close Tuesday with the Beach FC U17G Red being crowned national champions.

The US Club Soccer National Cup debuted in the summer of 2002 and has now grown to include Boys & Girls U11-U17 age groups in Super Group and Premier Divisions. The National Cup begins with eight regionals held across the country from Memorial Day weekend through the Fourth of July holiday weekend. Regional winners advance to the National Cup Finals in late July. Girls teams from across the country competed in two competitive divisions from U-13 through U-17, with 10 national championships awarded.

Beach FC U17G Red has advanced 4 times to the Virginia State Cup Final Four (3 of those times emerging as Virginia State Cup finalists), 4 time VCCL champions, and have had numerous tournament successes. During the US Club Soccer National Championship competition the Beach FC U17's scored 10 goals and conceded 1.
